Apps Menu

Swipe Down

Swipe down from the home screen to reach the Control Centre and access the Find my phone and Music options, and control your watch's brightness and turn notifications on/off.



Swipe Left to Right

Swipe right to access the Activity Dashboard and view your Steps for the day, Distance covered and Calories burnt.



Swipe Right to Left

Swipe left from the Home screen to view your System and App Notifications.



Swipe Up

Swipe Up from the Home screen to view all the Apps on your Fastrack Reflex watch.

Multi-Sports Tracking

Swipe up from the Home screen, choose Active Sports and pick from twelve different types of indoor and outdoor activities.



Once the workout is over, the Fastrack Reflex World app shows your workout summary

The app also shows daily/weekly/monthly data for your overall Multisport Summary

Heart Rate

From your Home Screen, swipe up to find Health Apps and tap on Heart Rate.

HR Result Display



The daily/weekly/monthly trends of your Heart Rate are available on the Reflex World app.

Heart Rate is categorized into 3 buckets - Low Fat Burn, Medium Fat Burn, and High Fat Burn.

Sleep Monitor

The watch automatically records the duration of your sleep and buckets it into categories like Light Sleep and and Deep Sleep.



SPO2

From the Home Screen, swipe up and click on the Health Apps option and choose SPO2 from the list.

Camera

Swipe up from the Home Screen to reach the All Apps option and tap on Camera.



Note: You have to first open the Reflex World app on your phone and then click on the camera control on the watch to take a picture.

Music

Swipe down from the Home Screen to reach the All Apps option and choose Music.



Note: The music feature on your watch works with the default music app on your phone.

Weather

Tap on weather from the All Apps menu to check the current weather conditions on your watch.



Note: Location services and Internet connectivity are needed for accurate weather information. All data is collated from the Open Weather online service.

Find My Phone

Swipe down from the home screen to get to the Control Center and tap on Find My Phone option.



Note: You need an active connection between your phone and the watch to use this feature.

Lift to View

To save battery, the watch screen turns off if you haven't been using it for a while. When you raise your hand, the Lift to View feature switches on the screen automatically.

Watch Faces

The Fastrack Reflex watch has 3 default watch faces and 1 cloud watch face. Users can choose from 25+ watch faces available on the Fastrack Reflex World app.



To change the watch face using the app: Go to settings, click on watch faces and install the watch face you like.



To change the watch face using your watch: Go to settings, tap watch faces and select the watch face of your choice.

Trouble Shooting

For common issues related to the watch, please follow the instructions below:

Unable to Switch on the Watch

Long press the push button for 3 seconds. If it still doesn't start, please charge the watch.

Automatic Shutdown

In case of low battery power, please charge the watch. If the problem persists, please contact our authorized dealers.

FAQs

Q: How many activities does the Fastrack Reflex watch support?

A: The watch supports 12 activities including Outdoor Walk, Outdoor Run, Outdoor Cycle, Indoor Walk, Indoor Run, HIIT, Yoga, Elliptical, Spinning, Hiking, Rowing, and Others.

Q: What does the Lift to View feature do?

A: This feature helps to conserve the battery of your watch. The smartwatch screen automatically turns off after you haven't used it for a while. Once you move your hand, it automatically turns on again.

Q: How many watch faces does the Fastrack Reflex watch offer?

A: The smartwatch comes with 3 pre-loaded watch faces. One more can be downloaded from the cloud from the 25+ available watch face options.

Q: How does the watch measure sleep quality?

A: The Fastrack Reflex watch categorizes your sleep in buckets like Deep Sleep and Light Sleep. Based on the number of hours recorded in each bucket, you also get an overall Sleep Score.

Q: Can I use my smartwatch to find my phone?

A: Yes. In such a case, you can swipe down from the home screen of your watch and tap "Find my Phone". Your phone starts beeping.
