IMPORTANT PRECAUTIONS


- 1. READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY.
- 2. Make sure that your outlet voltage corresponds to the voltage stated on the rating label of the toaster.
- 3. This appliance is not advised to be used by anyone(including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge, unless properly guided about the use of the appliance in a safe manner by the person concerned for their safety. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children unless they are older than 8 and supervised.
- 4. CAUTION: During operation the appliance heats up/becomes hot and it is therefore recommend avoid touching the metallic parts of the appliance with bare hands. Use handles or knobs only.
- 5. Before storing the appliance let it cool down. Then pull the plug from the socket.
- 6. To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plug, or any part of the toaster in water or other liquid.
- 7. Unplug unit from outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- 8. Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or in abnormal state. If its main cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, the nearest service agent or a qualified person.
- Do not operate the appliance near or below curtains and other combustible materials, they must be watched.
- 10. Do not let the cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surface.
- 11. Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- 12. Do not use the appliance for other than its intended use.
- 13. Don't attempt to dislodge food when toaster is in operation.
- 14. Oversize food, metal foil packages or utensils must not be inserted in the toaster as they may cause fire or electric shock.
- 15. When the bread is stuck unplug the toaster. Then use tongs to remove the bread. Be careful not to damage the heating wires and rendering the toaster inoperable.
- 16. The toaster is not suitable for preparation of sandwiches with fillings. ONLY toast bread slices therefore.
- 17. The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- 18. Be sure to take the bread out carefully after toasting so as to avoid injuries
- 19. This appliance has been incorporated with a grounded plug. Please ensure the wall outlet in your house is well earthed.
- 20. The appliance is not intended to be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote-control system.
- 21. *Warning:* if toast of small bread slices less than 85mm length, you must pay attention to the potential risk of burning when taking out the slices.
- 22. Don't use the appliance outdoors.

- 23. Use the appliance on a level and stable surface.
- 24. This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as:
 - staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
 - farm houses;
 - by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
 - bed and breakfast type environments.
- 25. Save these instructions.



PRODUCT DESCRIPTION



KEY FEATURES

Variable browning control - The color controller knob in the labeled diagram above allows the user to get the desired crispiness of toast. Some users may like to have crispy brown toasts while some may like it softer and less brown. Usha Popup Toaster allows user to get desired crispiness up to the maximum, 7 levels.

Easy to clean slide out crumb tray - Usha Popup Toaster comes with an easy to remove crumb tray to clean bread crumb collected due to toasting.

Mid cycle cancel function - A Mid cycle cancel function allows user to withdraw the bread being toasted from the slots at any point of time when the bread is being toasted.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Put bread slice into the bread slot, it can be inserted two slices at most every time. Only the regular slice can be placed into the bread slot.
 - **Note:** Make sure the crumb tray is completely positioned in place before using.
- 2. Plug the power cord into the outlet.
- Set color control knob to your desired color. There is 7-position level, the lowest is set white and the highest is dark. The bread slice can be toasted to golden color at the middle position.

Note:

- Toasting color for one side is darker than that for double bread at the same level.
- If toasted continuously, toasting color for the latter bread is darker than the color of previous cycle at the same level.
- 4. Press carriage handle down vertically until it is positioned in place, the indicator of Cancel will be illuminated and toasting begins. Once the bread has been toasted to the preset color, the carriage handle will automatically sprung up, and you can remove the bread readily.
 Next. The savings handle can only be latched when the appliance connects to the power.
 - **Note:** The carriage handle can only be latched when the appliance connects to the power supply.
- 5. During the toasting process, you may observe the toasting color. If it is satisfactory, you may interrupt the toasting process by pressing the **Cancel** button at any time.

CAUTION:

- 1. Remove all protective wrapping prior to toasting.
- 2. If toaster starts to smoke, press **Cancel** button to stop toasting immediately.
- 3. Avoid toasting the food with extremely runny ingredients such as butter.
- 4. Never attempt to remove bread, jammed in the slots without unplugging the toaster from the electrical outlet first. Be sure not to damage the internal mechanism or heating elements when removing bread.
- The bread slot is only applicable for toasting regular bread slice. Irregular bread or round bread cannot be toasted in the bread slot.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE:

- Disconnect the power supply before cleaning.
- 2. Wipe the outside with soft dry cloth after toaster cools down, never use metal polish.
- 3. Pull out the crumb tray on the bottom of toaster by crumb tray handle and empty it. If toaster is used frequently, accumulated bread crumbs should removed at least once a week. Make sure the crumb tray is completely closed before using the toaster again.
- 4. When not in use or storage, the power cord may be wound under the bottom of toaster.
