CAUTIONS


- 1 Read the instructions carefully before installation and keep them handy for future reference.
- 2 Keep the packaging out of the reach of children.
- 3 After opening the pack, ensure that no components are damaged and the fan is intact.
- 4 The fan is to be installed by a qualified technician to avoid any damages arising of wrong connections.
- 5 Never insert any object into the blade of the fan.
- 6 In the event of the fan failing to operate, all repairs must be undertaken by a company-approved service centre.
- 7 Do not install the fan where it could be exposed to excess vapour or direct water contact.
- 8 The fan should be used as an exhaust fan only.
- 9 When the ventilating fan is connected with the power circuit, all-polarity switches with at least 3mm contact gap must be in the charging line.
- 10 Precautions must be taken to avoid the back-flow of gases into the room from open gas flues or other open-fire appliances.

MAINTENANCE

- 1. Before carrying out any cleaning or servicing operations, always switch off the fan's power supply.
- 2. Never use petrol, benzene, thinner or any other chemicals for cleaning.
- 3. Use a moist cloth (not wet) to remove dirt from plastic surfaces.
- 4. Do not allow water to come into contact with electrical parts such as the motor or switches.
