

CAUTIONS

- 1 Read the instructions carefully before installation and keep them handy for future reference.
- 2 Keep the packaging out of the reach of children.
- 3 After opening the pack, ensure that no components are damaged and the fan is intact.
- 4 The fan is to be installed by a qualified technician to avoid any damages arising of wrong connections.
- 5 Never insert any object into the blade of the fan.
- 6 In the event of the fan failing to operate, all repairs must be undertaken by a company-approved service centre.
- 7 Do not install the fan where it could be exposed to excess vapour or direct water contact.
- 8 The fan should be used as an exhaust fan only.
- 9 When the ventilating fan is connected with the power circuit, all-polarity switches with at least 3mm contact gap must be in the charging line.
- 10 Precautions must be taken to avoid the back-flow of gases into the room from open gas flues or other open-fire appliances.

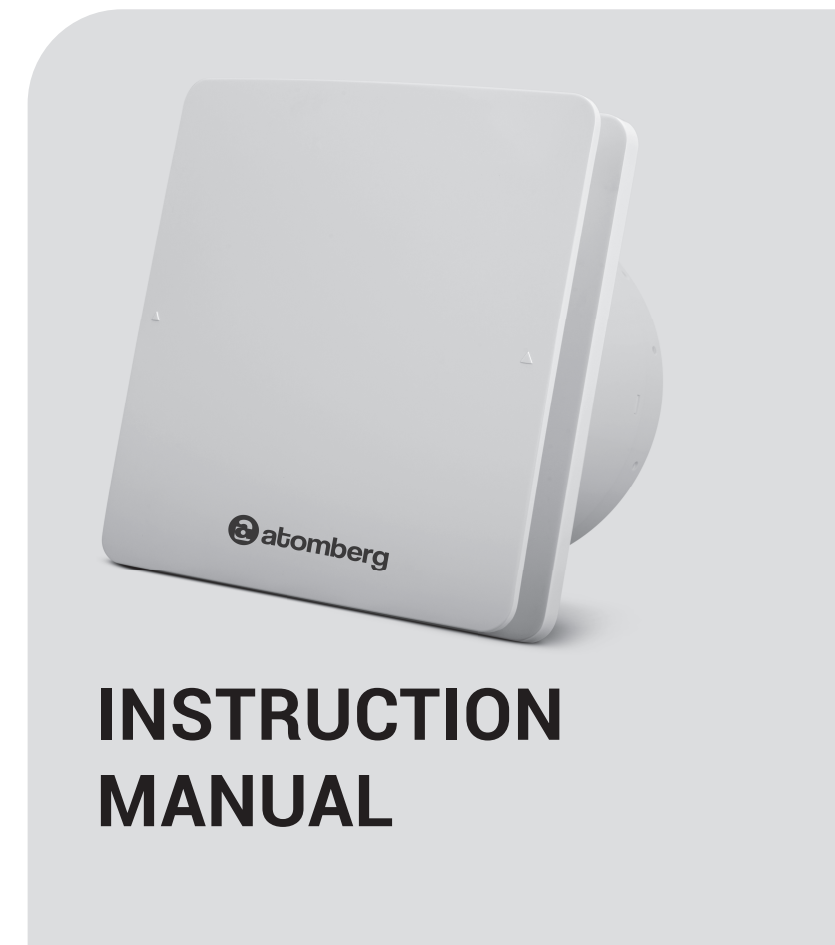
MAINTENANCE

1. Before carrying out any cleaning or servicing operations, always switch off the fan's power supply.
2. Never use petrol, benzene, thinner or any other chemicals for cleaning.
3. Use a moist cloth (not wet) to remove dirt from plastic surfaces.
4. Do not allow water to come into contact with electrical parts such as the motor or switches.
