Light indicator not working	If the power indicator is off, charge the keyboard using the Lightning cable.
Typing lag or delay	Ensure that other Bluetooth devices are not interfering; try disconnecting them.
Keyboard layout issues	Check the keyboard layout settings in your Apple device's system preferences.
