

UNPACKING AND SET UP

Place your soundbar on a level surface such as a table, desk, or shelf, convenient to an AC outlet, out of direct sunlight, and away from sources of excess heat, dirt, dust moisture, humidity, or vibration, Unwind the line cord connecting the AC adapter and extend it to its full length.


INSTALLATION - FREE STANDING



Place the soundbar horizontally on a flat surface such as a TV unit or shelf and align it entrally with the TV screen

Allow some space between the soundbar and the wall. Don't place it inside a cabinet or a walled shelf. Follow this guidance for the best ound output and good airflow around the soundbar.

FRONT LED DISPLAY



GENERAL OPERATION

REMOTE CONTROL **OVERVIEW**

1.STANDBY: When under standby mode, single press this button to power on the soundbar. When under working state, single press this button to shut down into Standby mode. The front display LED turns red in Standby mode. Long press this button to reset Bluetooth pairing or make it Default Volume, Bass & Treble from any of its working mode

2. MUTE: Single press this button to mute or unmute the audio. 3. INPUT: Press this button to switch between

USB/AUX/BT/HDMI input modes 4. BT: Single Press this button to select Bluetooth playback. Long press this button for disconnecting BT paired device

5. VOL+ : Single press or long press this button to increase the volume 6. PREV: When under USB/BT modes, press this

4. Connect the USB flash drive to the USB port on the soundbar or by USB adapter (or your own USB extension cable connected to the USB port), and the music will be 5. Press the VOL +/- buttons to adjust the volume to your desired level.

PLAYING via AUX MODE:

1 Firstly connect the soundbar to your PC lanton smart-phone TV or other audio devices by using an AUX cable. Use a 35mm to 35mm audio cable to connect the PC tablet, smartphone, TV's headphone socket to the AUX socket on the soundbar. Make sure that these devices have both AUX IN and AUX OUT terminals.

. Then press the INPUT button on the remote control or long press the play/pause button on the soundbar to switch the soundbar to AUX mode. Once the soundbar is connected in AUX mode, the front display LED turns green and the music on your connected device will play. Playback can only be controlled from your connected

2. Using a high-speed HDMI (ARC) cable, connect the HDMI (ARC) connector on the soundbar to the HDMI (ARC) connector on the TV. The HDMI (ARC) connector on the TV might be labelled differently. For details, see the user manual of your TV. 3. When HDMI (ARC) is connected, TV sound setting in "sound output" mode should be

set as Auto mode. Then start playing music on the TV. 4. Press the INPUT button on the remote control or long press the play/pause button on the soundbar to select HDMI (ARC) mode.

1. When connecting a device such as a TV/Set-top box/DVD/ game console with HDMI

(ARC) cable, set the audio output mode of the device to Auto mode <digital HDMI (ARC) output>. 2. The TV is connected to a HDMI (ARC) port with soundbar. Different TVs might have
